Academics

The CBSE 12th results for the academic year have been announced, showcasing the top performs across three streams: Humanities, Science, and Commerce. In the Humanities stream, Jaishik Barwal secured the first position with an impressive score of 94.2%, followed closely by Hanshik Choudhary with 94%, and Jahnvi Gupta with 89% The Science stream saw Abhishek Singh leading with 87.2%, Niharika Chaudhary in second place with 85.8%, and Himanshu Kumawat in third with 85% It the Commerce stream, Akshara Parwal topped the liswith 94%, followed by Mann Sharma with 86.6%, and Hardik Jain with 82.6%.

In class 10th CBSE result the top achievers for the academic year are as following-Yashika Choudhan secured the first position with an outstanding score 96.4%. Akshita Bhardwaj and Yashi Jain both achieved the second position, each scoring 93.2%

Drishti Choudhary followed closely in the third position with a score of 92.4%. These results reflect the students' hard work and dedication, showcasing their academic excellence and commitment to their studies.

Other notable achievements include Vandit Bansal from class 9A1 securing the 2nd position in Ice Skating and qualifying for the National level, and Mayank Kumawat and Trilok Kumawat from class 11B and 11C respectively, qualifying for the National level in shooting.

In the JECRC Inter School Badminton tournament, Tanuj Choudhary from class 12B and Gourav Sharma from class 11B both secured the third position.
